10/11/2012	10/11/2012	763 INFORMED BY TCSO THAT INDIVIDUAL IS INSIDE BUILDING AT 95 CHESTNUT STREET AND HE IS NOT TO BE THERE. 763 SERVED STOP WORK ORDER ON JOSEPH BREITWIESER LAST WEEK FOR CODE ENFORCEMENT - 763 RESEARCHED INFORMATION AS 753 MADE PHONE CALLS ON SITUATION WITH JOSEPH BEING REPORTED TO BE INSIDE BUILDING. 763 FOUND THAT JOSEPH COULD BE ARRESTED UNDER EXECUTIVE LAW 382-2 (UNCLASSIFIED MISDEMEANOR) FOR VIOLATING THE SERVED STOP WORK ORDER. 763 RESPONDED TO LOCATION AFTER 753 STATED ARREST COULD BE MADE. 763 RESPONDED AND OBSERVED JOSEPH SHOVELING MATERIAL INTO HIS TRUCK (CODE ENFORCEMENT HAD TOLD 763 LAST WEEK, DURING SERVICE OF STOP WORK ORDER TO JOSEPH, THAT MATERIAL CONTAINS ASBESTOS AND JOSEPH IS NOT TO BE CLEANING IT UP). 763 ARRESTED JOSEPH.
